The WCL PFA enrichment program gives Dorchester students an opportunity to try classes in a familiar and convenient setting. **Our program depends on the help of parent volunteers to chaperone our classes. As such, a chaperone commitment is required during registration. PFA Membership required to enroll in enrichments.**

REGISTRATION

Online registration for the winter enrichment session will begin on Sunday, December 8th at 6:30pm for grades K-2 and 7:00pm for grades 3-5 (and any grade 2 students who would like to sign up for chess). Class sizes are limited, and are filled on a first-come, first-served basis. **If a class is filled and you would like to be put on a waitlist, please send an email ASAP to enrichmentwclpfa@gmail.com.** Please do not contact the enrichment chairs individually. Waitlist requests will be honored in the order received based on your email time stamp. **You cannot register for another student that is not your child.** Registration will close on Sunday, December 15th. During the week leading up to the start of class, you will receive the chaperone schedule and arrival and dismissal procedures from the volunteer coordinator for that class.

CHAPERONE POLICY

We require each parent to chaperone for classes in which their children are enrolled. You typically will chaperone once per session **per child** enrolled in the class, unless the class size is smaller than usual and you may need to chaperone an additional time. If you have multiple children enrolled, then you will need to chaperone once per each child.

If it is not possible for a parent/caregiver to attend, you may request to send someone else over the age of 18 to chaperone in your place. Substitutes will be approved on a case-by-case basis.

If you have a last-minute conflict with your chaperone date, it is your responsibility to find a replacement within the pool of parents that have children registered for the class. If a replacement cannot be found, class may be canceled. If you do not abide by our chaperone policy, we reserve the right to possibly deny future enrichment registration.

ENRICHMENT CLASS COORDINATORS

Each class requires one enrichment coordinator for it to run. This is an easy way to volunteer for the PFA without a big time commitment! Coordinator responsibilities are simply to create a chaperone schedule and send out weekly reminders to the upcoming chaperones. We provide an email template which the coordinator would update and customize for each class.

REFUND POLICY/MAKEUP CLASSES

Any cancellation requests must be received before the second class. Refunds (minus a 3% processing fee) will only be given if there is a student on the waitlist who will be taking your child's spot. No refunds will be given after the second class. There are no individual make-ups. Should a class be canceled by the instructor or school, we will advise on a make-up date.

BEHAVIOR POLICY

Appropriate school behavior is expected for all the students to ensure a positive experience for the entire class. Children are expected to listen to the instructor and chaperone, be respectful of other students and participate in all activities. After the Bell students are not permitted to leave until the end of the class.

If any child is disrupting the class, does not respond to a request to change behavior, or engages in other concerning behavior, chaperones should contact the Enrichment Chairs, who will contact the school administration. The school administration will then promptly reach out to the parent(s) regarding such behavior. If the child's behavior is not remedied, we will ask that the student be chaperoned each week by their parent/caregiver or withdraw from the class without a refund.

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE

After school, children will be escorted from their classrooms to their enrichment. Upon dismissal from the enrichment, children will be picked up in their designated area. All students must be signed out by a parent/caregiver. ATB students will be signed out to and brought directly back to the ATB program. More specific arrival and departure information will be provided the week before class.

ABSENCES

Please email the class coordinators if your child will be absent from class, so they can inform the chaperones. You will not be eligible for a refund for any missed classes.
