Zensational Kids Classroom Training	Zensational Kids provides mindful breath and movement practices to help students and educators thrive in and out of the classroom. Additionally, there is also a school-wide assembly planned for next year. This funding would provide for an approximate four-week program, where Zensational instructors would make 1/2 hour visits (once per week) to the classrooms and work with the students on their techniques. Would be mobile and could be used throughout the building by entire staff.
