When will am/pm designations be available?

Before the end of June you will receive your class assignment. Watch for you email in-box.

Is the School Supply list available?

Yes. Visit braesidepto.org for more information, view the list and purchase by May 31st to have your child's supplies delivered directly to his classroom.

When will I receive information about my child's bus route?

August, typically via a letter mailed via USPS from the District.

What are district fees:

Each student in the district is required to pay a student fee. You will receive a letter from the district in June that includes an explanation of the fees with a student ID number and directions to on how to pay the fees. The PTO keeps a separate calendar featuring special events such as school picture day, PTO meetings and other special events located at www.braesidepto.org

After school playdates:

Each child must bring a note explaining who he/she will be going home with signed by a parent or guardian. The note should be placed in the children's take-home folder that they will receive during their first week of school.

What if a message needs to be delivered to my child during the school day about a change of pick up plans?

In case of emergency, call the school office as soon as possible and a message will be delivered to the student's teacher. It is important to realize that interruptions to teaching be kept at a minimum.

Can my child bring a friend home on the bus?

No, if your child takes the bus home and is having a friend come home from school with him, alternate arrangements must be made for pick up.

What should I do if my child will be absent?

Each parent will have the opportunity to register for the School Directory App. This app is provided by the Braeside PTO and includes the school directory for every family that registers on the PTO website as well as other functions including Absent Notice. You can send a message to the nurse, your child's teacher and the school office via this app. If you choose not to purchase the app (and therefore not be included in the school directory) you must call the school nurse at 224-765-3400, before 8:40 am

Where can I sign up to join the Braeside PTO?

Visit www.braesidepto.org. The Braeside PTO meets the first Friday of every month in the school cafeteria (also called the Character Cafe) at 9:00 am. By registering with the PTO you will receive bi-monthly electronic newsletters, be able to purchase tickets to PTO-hosted events online, volunteer online for special events including working in the library, acting as room parent and many more opportunities.

Where do I drop off and pick up my child on the first day of school?

Each day all students will be dropped off at the front entrance. Kindergarten students that do not take the bus will be released to a parent or care taker at the teacher outside Door #TBD.
