Registration Procedures

CLASS DATES:

For the spring session, classes will run from Monday, April 1st - Friday, May 31, 2019. Class dates can differ slightly; please see the schedule grid for specific class dates. There are no enrichment classes on days when school is closed, cancelled, or unexpectedly dismissed early. **There will not be refunds/make ups for classes that are missed due to school cancellations.** Please look at the grid for class specific days off.

After making your class selections please **PAY & CHECK OUT COMPLETELY!**

On Wednesday, there are two sessions of enrichment available for registration; 2:30-3:30 and 3:30-4:30. You may register a student for both hours of enrichment or you can choose either the first hour or the second hour. If you only register for the 3:30-4:30 class, your child must exit the building at 2:25 when school is dismissed (unless the student is in after school club).

PROCESSING FEES FOR DROPS/CHANGE REQUESTS:

After **checkout** is complete a **\$25 fee** is charged for any dropped class.
After **first week** of classes there is **NO REFUND**.

If a lottery is necessary, drop/change fees are waived.

SCHOLARSHIPS:

Scholarships are available for families who need assistance with tuition. Please contact Mrs. Jackson, the principal, for additional information.

EMERGENCY AND PLEDGE:

We **must** have emergency information on file for each child. As part of the online payment process you must provide this information including allergies or additional circumstances of which the instructors should be aware. The enrichment pledge and allergy pledge must be initialed.

LOTTERY:

In the event that registration for a specific class exceeds the maximum allowed for that class, a lottery will be run following the priority registration deadline.

PTO BEHAVIOR POLICY:

The PTO reserves the right to terminate the participation of any student in the enrichment program for disruptive behavior. Additionally, if the PTO or program supervisors consider the continued participation of the student to interfere with the staff to manage the activities of the program, a student's participation may be terminated. **Further, all students are reminded not to touch the personal belongings of the students and teachers whose classrooms they use during enrichment.** Failure to comply with this may result in the student being terminated from the program. There are no refunds provided if a student's participation is terminated due to disruptive behavior.

CODE OF CONDUCT:

A student participating in an enrichment activity will be held to the code of conduct of School District 109.

THE STUDENT SHALL NOT:

1. Violate the District's policies or procedures on student discipline.
2. Use a beverage containing alcohol.
3. Use tobacco in any form.
4. Use, possess, buy, sell, barter, or distribute any illegal substance or paraphernalia.
5. Use, possess, buy, sell, barter or distribute any object that is or could be considered a weapon or any item that is a look alike weapon.
6. Act in an unsportsmanlike manner.
7. Vandalize or steal.
8. Haze or bully another student.
9. Violate the written rules for the activity.
10. Behave in a manner that is detrimental to the good of the group or the enrichment class.
11. Be insubordinate or disrespectful toward the activity's staff.
12. Falsify any information contained on any permit or permission form required.

Hazing and bullying activities are strictly forbidden at any time and in any location. Hazing is any humiliation or dangerous activity expected of a student to belong to a team or group, regardless of his or her willingness to participate. Bullying is any physical or verbal act or conduct that has or can be reasonably predicted to place a student in reasonable fear of harm; cause a detrimental effect on a student's physical or mental health; interfere with a student's academic performance; or interfere with a student's ability to participate in or benefit from school activities.

ENRICHMENT ATTENDANCE MONITOR:

The enrichment attendance monitor is on duty daily from 3:30 – 4:30 to monitor attendance in after school enrichment classes and Wednesdays from 2:30-4:30. **If your child will not be at his/her after school**

enrichment class, you must call the school office by 3:00 or 2:00 Wednesday, the day of the class. Additionally, you must notify your child's classroom teacher so that she/he knows to send your child home rather than the enrichment class. This applies only to after school classes, not lunch bunch enrichment.

**Class Descriptions
AFTER SCHOOL ENRICHMENT**

AMAZING ART (Grades K-5)

Amazing Art combines all your favorite art projects and mixed media in this unique class. Kids will make Tie Dye shirts (art smocks for the session), experience pottery painting, create fired ceramic arts, paint a canvas acrylic painting, do recycled art projects and more. Lessons will include concepts and techniques kids can use for a lifetime and the experience of creating awesome projects will result in great self-esteem and a sense of accomplishment. BASKETBALL (Grades 4-5)

Instructors will guide students through core concepts of electrical engineering, introducing them to circuits and electrical components. Students will use hands-on projects and experiments to explore how electricity is part of our daily lives. No previous experience is necessary, just a desire to learn and build. Projects will include: a disc launcher, electronic games, musical instruments, alarms, and more, along with fun-filled class activities! Each student will receive an award on the last day of the session, as well as the opportunity to earn engineering belts to demonstrate their learned skills!

LET'S CODE IT – Digital Design(Grades 3-5)

Let's Code It Programming – Digital Design – Your child will have a blast designing video games and animations in this exciting STEM program. Our innovative approach to coding is sure to spark your child's interest in computer science, using a kid-friendly, intuitive, block-based programming system called Scratch, developed by the MIT Media Lab. The fun filled curriculum hones important skills related to problem solving, attention to detail, creativity, storytelling and critical thinking. Class topics include conditional statements, cloning, variables, loops, control structure, object oriented design concepts and data structures. Each student will receive an award on the last day of the session, and will have the opportunity to earn Code Belts to demonstrate their learned skills!

LITTLE FOOTLIGHTERS (Grades K-2)

Perfect for first and second graders, Little Footlighters increases creativity and self-confidence both onstage and off! Through theatre games, rehearsal and performance, students develop basic acting skills and rehearsal technique necessary to be successful in performance.

MAGIC CLASS TUESDAY, APRIL 9th (Grades K-5)

Children will have a great time as they learn a collection of thrilling and mesmerizing tricks from the "Magic Team of Gary Kantor." Amaze family and friends with tricks that involve cards, ropes, coins, mind-reading, and more. All materials are provided, and each child receives a magic kit to take home. Children are grouped by age and always learn tricks that are age-appropriate. Additionally, you can sign up for this class again and again since brand new tricks are always taught at each session! **Note: If your child has taken Gary Kantor's magic classes at the Park District, some of the tricks may be the same.**

MANDARIN (GRADES 1-3)

This class is designed for Mandarin beginners. It contains counting basic numbers, introducing yourself, saying hello in different scenarios, telling color, and learning culture. After taking this class, students are expected to know how to introduce themselves including their name, age, grade, family members, understand and speak basic action phrases. The class integrates music, dance, and movement into teaching. At the end of class, students will perform their Chinese songs, dance, writing, and speaking. During the learning of Chinese culture, students will experience the diversity of Chinese food, festival, habit, and etc. Students will open their minds to celebrate diversity.

This program is intended for students have not had exposure to coding.
