



# CCPL Summer Reading Program Incentives from the LSE PTA

Complete the Summer Reading Program at the Carroll County Public Library by August 31 to earn rewards and be entered into a prize drawing sponsored by the LSE PTA!



All LSE students who complete the CCPL Summer Reading Program (by earning 300+ points) will:

- Receive a **completion gift** in late September or October, after CCPL generates their participation data and shares it with LSE.
- Earn a **Raffle Ticket** for a chance to win one of our awesome PRIZES (Games, Squishmallows, Arts and Crafts, STEM Kits and more!)

As a special incentive, **LSE students who go on to earn 1,000 points in the CCPL Summer Reading Program, will earn 2 additional Raffle Tickets (for a total of 3) in the PRIZE drawing!**

To be eligible for the prize raffle, you must register for and complete the Summer Reading Program at a CCPL branch or through the Beanstack Tracker app/website. The program ends on August 31 and no late submissions are accepted.

Students at LSE in grades PreK-5 for the 2024-2025 school year are eligible. **IMPORTANT: When you register for the program with CCPL, make sure you have LSE and the correct grade listed for your child on their Reader profile to ensure they are eligible for prizes at LSE.** These prizes from LSE PTA are in addition to prizes offered by CCPL for participation.

## FAQs

### **Our family will be away a lot this summer. Can we still participate?**

Absolutely! Download the Beanstack Tracker app (free on App Store and Google Play), register for the reading program and you can track your child's reading and activities from anywhere.

### **Do I have to read books from the public library for them to count?**

No, any reading counts. If you have books at home, you can read them. You can also read on a tablet or a kid's reading app such as Raz Kids.

### **We don't have a library card. Can we still participate?**

Yes! We encourage you to apply for a free library card at CCPL to take advantage of their wonderful resources both in print and electronically. You can still register for the Summer Reading Program if you don't have a CCPL card.

### **Can we just keep a paper log and turn it in?**

Yes, you can do that too but please make sure it is turned in to any CCPL library branch (Eldersburg, Westminster, Finksburg, etc) by August 31 to be counted for CCPL incentives and for the PTA incentives offered to LSE students.

### **We live close to Howard County and do the Howard County summer reading program. Does this count toward the prizes offered by LSE PTA?**

Unfortunately, it doesn't because LSE doesn't get results reported from Howard County libraries. Only the CCPL summer reading program counts for the LSE PTA incentives.

### **When will my child receive their completion gift for finishing the program?**

The completion gifts will be distributed in late September or October.

### **When is the Prize Drawing?**

The Prize Drawing will be held in late September or October. Raffle tickets will be drawn by LSE staff and winners can pick a prize from the selection, first come, first served.
