Winter Workshops Course Descriptions 2019

ART CLUB 1 Learn the Beauty of Watercolor (Panebianco)

Explore the basics of watercolor, mixing and applying paint, correcting mistakes, and saving the white of the paper. Experiment with exciting tricks and techniques, all in a non-stressful and fun environment. Students will create several finished paintings, from landscape to still life, while getting a good feel for a unique, enjoyable, and very beautiful medium. Classes will include painting demonstrations and one-on-one instruction.

Materials fee \$22 max 12 students grades 3-8 10:30 am

ART CLUB 2 Learn from the Classics (Panebianco)

Learn to draw from the classics. We will draw self portraits, as we discuss classic portraits by Salvador Dali, Picasso, and Andy Warhol. Also learn free-form line drawing of landscape and still life. Learn to shade and produce value painting. As we learn different techniques from different artists, we will apply their style and make it our own. We will use graphite pencil, colored pencil, watercolor and watercolor pencil, and crayons and/or oil pastel.

Materials fee \$20 max 12 students grades 2-8 11:30

ART IN THE DARK (Bravo) - NEW CLASS!!!

Try your hand at glow in the dark art. Students will create different art that glows such as window clings, Holiday projects, slime, clay creatures, yard lanterns, tote bags, room signs, snow globes and more. Fun projects that will bring smiles for years to come. Dress for a mess!

Materials fee \$20 max 12 students grades K-8 9:30

BROADWAY BOUND 2 (Garver)

Join in movement, theatre games, and improv while working towards a presentation at the end of the six weeks. The group will decide on the scenes. Possible suggestions for this year range from "Mama Mia" - to "Grease," but we will do what the group finds most exciting and interesting. Ms. Garver toured as April O'Neil in the Ninja Turtles and holds a BA in Speech and Theatre from Rowan University. Wear comfortable clothing.

Materials fee \$5 max 12 students grades 5-8 10:30

BUILD WITH LEGOS (Bombace)

Learn about the history of Legos; use Legos to create superheroes, robots, modes of transportation, skyscrapers, or a famous work of art. Work together as a team and individually. Draft a plan and use Legos to make your creation. All Legos are supplied and each child will receive a new Lego kit at the completion of the course.

Materials fee \$10 max 12 students 9:30 & 10:30 (3-6) 11:30 (K-2)

CAKE AND COOKIE DECORATING (Bravo) ALL NEW PROJECTS!!

Kids will work with various baked items each week to create an edible masterpiece. They will learn the basics of cake frosting and decorating using icing bags and fondant. They will create cookie bouquets, scenes, standing cakes, candy sushi, and learn chocolate dipping. Fun to create edible art to take home and snack in class. One of our most popular classes. (Not recommended for those with food allergies.) This is a dress for the mess class.

CARTOON CREATIONS (Bravo)

Students will learn the art of cartoon drawing, create and perfect their own characters. They will make a flip book as well as a cartoon strip. What can your child create?

Materials fee \$20 max 25 students grades 3-8 9:30

CHESS (Chen)

Come learn chess strategy, practice your new moves against other players and compete in a chess tournament with a grand prize. All levels welcome - a basic understanding of how the pieces move is the only prerequisite.

CREATE WITH CLAY (Bravo) ALL NEW PROJECTS!!

Kids create a variety of small figurines using soft oven bake clay. They progress from basic sculpting techniques to more intricate figures, scenes and keepsakes. They will complete a creation each week and end the session with the skills to continue creating at home. One of our most popular classes, anyone can do it!

CREATIVE CHOCOLATE FOR BEGINNERS (Vavosa)

Make and taste creative chocolates! Amaze your family when you bring home your delicious projects each week. Always a favorite Winter Workshop class!

CREATIVE CHOCOLATE INTERMEDIATE (J. Davies)

Make and taste creative molded chocolates. Amaze your family when you bring home your delicious projects each week. Always something different to create!

Materials fee \$25 grades 2-4 max 12 students 9:30 11:30

CREATIVE CHOCOLATE ADVANCED (J. Davies)

Make and taste elaborate molded chocolates and more. Amaze your family when you bring home your delicious projects each week.

CURTAINS UP (Garver)

Join in movement, theatre games, and improv while working towards a presentation at the end of the six weeks. We will produce scenes and numbers from "Beauty and the Beast," and "Pocahontas" with everyone getting a turn to play their favorite role. Bring your ideas to class and let's see what we can create together! Ms. Garver toured as April O'Neil in the Ninja Turtles and holds a BA in Speech and Theatre from Rowan University. Wear comfortable clothing.

Materials fee \$5 max 12 students grades 3-5 9:30

INTRODUCTION TO CREATIVE HAND STITCHING (DiGregorio)

Students will learn the beautiful art of hand stitchery in this class which covers how to work with a pattern, proper use of hand sewing tools, beginner stitches and sewing safety. They will enjoy learning the basics of hand sewing while creating a cute "Dory" like FISH (similar to a Glow Fish), OR a Sweet Mouse using colorful felt, thread, and sewing notions of their choice. Finished project may be used as a shelf sitter, hung up, or even given as a gift! Approximate finished size: 8" X 9"

Materials fee \$10 grades: 3 - 8 max 10 students 9:30

CREATIVE HAND STITCHING 101 (DiGregorio)

Have fun learning the beautiful art of hand stitchery while creating an adorable Snowman, Snowlady, or a Penguin. You will use felt, thread, fabric, buttons, and other sewing notions of your own choice to complete this unique shelf sitter for your own room or to give as a gift. Finished project stands 8" tall.

Materials fee \$10 grades 4-8 max 10 students 10:30

CREATIVE HAND STITCHING 2 (DiGregorio)

Enjoy learning the basics of hand stitchery in this fun class. Using a pattern, students will pin, cut, and sew a Colorful Felt Flower with a button center and hand stitched leaves. The flower will then be placed in clay flower pot and Spanish moss will be used as a filler. Personal choice of materials enables each student to make this Spring Project a "one of a kind treasure". Finished project stands 10" tall.

Materials fee \$10 grades 4-8 max 10 students 11:30

DANCE (Cohen)

Stretching, toning, and lots of dance games ~ Get ready for fun! Please wear comfortable and breathable clothing (leggings/tights and a t-shirt). Tennis shoes or dance shoes are preferred footwear as dancing with boots, flats, or socks can be uncomfortable. Please do not feel obligated to buy dance shoes. Be sure to send your child/children with a water bottle.

Materials fee - None max 15 students
grades: K-2 9:30 K-2 10:30 3-6 11:30

FASHION (Bravo)

Classes will make a variety of do it yourself useful projects from scratch. Children can make their own pillows, journals, bulletin board, backpack, cell phone case, carrying tote, t shirt or other projects chosen by the class.

Materials fee \$20 grades: K-8 max 25 students 11:30

FUNKY PAINTING (Bravo)

Class will enjoy painting a variety of objects to keep for years to come. Make and paint funky sculptures, pictures using imagination and many different kinds of paints and techniques. This is a dress for a mess class.

Materials fee \$20 grades K-8 max 25 students 11:30

JEWELRY MAKING (Bravo)

Learn beading and jewelry making. Make your own baked clay beads and clay jewelry. Enjoy making Indian loom bracelets, macramé, friendship bracelets. Create earrings, necklaces, bracelets, pins jewelry holders and more.

Materials fee \$20 grades K-8 max 25 students 9:30

MAKE YOUR OWN TOYS, GAMES AND MORE (Bravo)

Class will choose from a variety of make your own projects such as banks, games, race cars, birdhouses, treasure boxes, ring toss games and night lites. We will work with small hand tools, so dress for a mess.

Materials fee \$20 grades K-8 max students 25 10:30

PHOTOGRAPHY - BEGINNING (Horvath)

A little history and an intro to a really cool art form: Photography. The Exposure Triangle: depth of field, aperture, shutter speed. We will learn about composing the shot and how to look at objects. We will also meet the camera. What are the parts of a camera and how do I take care of them? Learn about types of digital cameras and accessories. We will take portraits both silly and formal and will take to the streets for photojournalism. There will be special homework photography projects. Bring your digital camera with a memory card.

Materials fee - None grades 2- 8 max 12 students 9:30 10:30

PHOTOGRAPHY- ADVANCED (Horvath)

Learn about the digital darkroom, uploading photos to your computer and getting organized. Learn to edit and manipulate your photos, from cropping to special effects. Learn to use free photo editing programs. Also learn about careers in photography. Bring your digital camera with a memory card.

Materials fee - None grades 3-8 max students 12 11:30

POKÉMON (Dunn)

Learn to play the Pokemon Trading Card Game. This course will go over the basic rules for beginners as well as allow more advanced players to customize their own decks and discuss game strategy. All participants will receive a pre-built 60 card Theme Deck. Beginners will

be taught the rules of the game and will be able to practice with their fellow classmates. Those who are familiar with the rules and have experience will be allowed to modify and customize their decks at the discretion of the courses teacher.

STAINED GLASS, DECOUPAGE AND MOSAIC (Bravo)

Using stained glass paint and leading, students will learn how to create their own designs, prepare the glass & complete full color projects. Design your own window clings! Learn to paint on glass to create shadow jars, mirrors, etc. Plan and design mosaics, frames, jewelry boxes, signs etc. This is a dress for the mess class.

Materials fee \$20 grades K-8 max 25 students 11:30

WHAT'S COOKING (P. Davies)

Do you like to help in the kitchen? Want to be the next Master Chef Junior? Learn or improve your cooking skills through a teacher instructed - hands on approach. We have all new recipes this year for breakfast, lunch and snacks. We will end the session with a championship bake off! All recipes are completely nut free!

WOODWORKING & BUILDING FOR KIDS (Bravo)
