Registration: DEADLINE FOR REGISTRATION IS ON THURSDAY, January 10TH AT 1:00PM FOR MONDAY-WEDNESDAY CLASSES. THE DEADLINE FOR THURSDAY AND FRIDAY CLASSES, IS THIS FRIDAY, January 11TH AT 1:00PM.

PRE-REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED. Students not registered will be sent to the Front Office. Register online at www.agourahillsrec.org or in person at the Agoura Hills Recreation and Event Center – 29900 Ladyface Court. Refunds, credits or transfers are only given to students who withdraw or transfer prior to the second meeting of each class. Discounts will not be given for late registrations. The enrichment program is privately run and is not affiliated with Yerba Buena Elementary school and/or Las Virgenes Unified School District. ***NEW: PRICES FOR CLASSES ARE ALL INCLUSIVE. THERE WILL BE NO LATE FEES IF YOU ENROLL AFTER THE DEADLINE. HOWEVER, CLASSES AT THAT TIME ARE SUBJECT TO CANCELLATION***

27 minute Club: 1st – 3rd graders taking enrichment on Mon/Tue/Thu/Fri are automatically enrolled into 27 minute club from 2:06-2:33pm and will go to enrichment directly afterwards.

CLASSES RUN FROM 1/14-3/22

After School:

- 1st-5th Graders: Students who are in 1st-3rd Grade will walk over to the 27 Minute Club after school. They will then be escorted to their Enrichment class. Students in 4th-5th Grade will walk over to their Enrichment class after school.
- Journeys/Kindergarten: Students will be picked up at their classroom by a City staff member and will be escorted to their Enrichment class.
- Wednesday: Journeys/Kindergarten students will be picked up by a City staff member and will be escorted to the lunch tables. 1st -5th Graders will walk themselves to the lunch tables. Supervised lunch is from 12:10-12:45pm.

Pick-Up Procedures:

Journeys and Kindergarten students will need to be picked up in person at their enrichment class. Grades 1st – 5th can either be picked up at the classroom or students can sign themselves out if indicated on the parent authorization pick-up form. YMCA students will be escorted to the YMCA facility.

Late Pick-up Policy: The Department of Community Services personnel are unavailable to supervise children after the enrichment class. If a child is picked up late from a program a \$10.00 late pick-up fee will be assessed for every 30 minutes of employee overtime. This charge must be paid prior to the next class meeting. Two documented late pick-up notices of 15 minutes each will be considered a 30-minute violation and a fine will be imposed. If a child is picked up late two or more times they may be dropped from the class without a refund.

Important: Students must be picked up immediately after their enrichment class. There is NO supervision for enrichment students after classes, unless attending the YMCA.
